

Home Education – TieNET Coding: Mary

Here is the information for Home Education:

Coding for Students who were on an IEP and then placed in Home Education by parent.

TieNet Case Management System

Profile Tab- Demographic/Enrollment section- check the Home Education box. Then go to the Eligibility Section and fill-in the student's primary disability, and the setting/educational environment. For students in Home Education, the setting/educational environment is Parentally Placed in Private School.

The parent is responsible to submit a home education service plan and outline the special education and related services needed by their child. The school does not create an IEP or a private school ISP within TieNet. The school can upload the parents' required home education service plan as an attachment into TieNet, as well as any progress reports or the determination of reasonable annual progress.

If the student is not receiving any special education or related services from the district, create an exit form and list it as "Moved Known to be Continuing."

Note- Unless the parent no longer resides in the district, the student will continue to be enrolled from year to year with an approved home education option. A TieNet exit form listed as "moved, known to be continuing" will need to be completed each year, if the parent submits another letter to home educate and a home education service plan.

STARs

If the student is receiving special education and related services from the school district, the student must have a course enrollment in STARs.

Note- Coding the setting/educational environment in this way within TieNet and a course enrollment within STARs feeds the data pull for the federal child count and triggers state funding for those students who receive some service from the district. It does not confer the same IDEA rights as a student with a disability in private school.
